- 1 (a) "Paul was a missionary, a leader and a hero."

With reference to selected passages, discuss this description of Paul in relation to the journey to Rome. [30]

- (b) Critically evaluate the claim that the challenge of the gospel reaching the ends of the earth is still ongoing. [20]

- 2 (a) Analyse the reasons for and discuss what happened at the Council of Jerusalem. [30]

- (b) Critically assess the view that this Council was the most significant event for the growth of the Church. [20]

- 3 (a) Discuss how Paul defended his authority and the gospel in the opening chapters of Galatians. [30]

- (b) With reference to Acts and the Letters, critically assess the claim that Paul was highly successful at presenting speeches and arguments to persuade his audience. [20]

- 4 (a) Analyse the reasons for and discuss Paul's teaching on unity and lawsuits as found in Corinthians. [30]

- (b) "The teaching of Paul to the Corinthians on sexual morality is totally irrelevant for Christians today."

Critically evaluate this view. [20]
