- 2 Say what sort of programmes you like watching.
- 3 Say why.
- 4 Say where you watch TV.
- 5 Say what else you do in the evening.

Family

Instructions to the candidate:

You are talking to your German friend about your family.

Your teacher will play the part of your friend.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Say whether you have brothers and sisters.
- 2 Say which member of your family you get on well with.
- 3 Say why.
- 4 Say what job **one** of your parents has.
- 5 Say if he/she likes it and why.

SITUATION D

Eating out

Instructions to the candidate:

You are in a restaurant in Austria.

Your teacher will play the part of the waiter/waitress.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Give your name and say you reserved a table.
- 2 Order something to drink.
- 3 Order a main course.
- 4 Say it was delicious.
- 5 Thank the waiter/waitress and ask for the bill.

Friends

Instructions to the candidate:

You are discussing your friend with your German exchange partner.

Your teacher will play the part of your exchange partner.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Say what your best friend is called and spell it in German.
- 2 Say where he/she lives.
- 3 Say what he/she looks like.
- 4 Say what type of person he/she is. (Give **two** details.)
- 5 Say what you do together at the weekend.

SITUATION F

A birthday celebration

Instructions to the candidate:

You are talking to your German friend about your sister's birthday party.

Your teacher will play the part of your German friend.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Say when and where the party is.
- 2 Say how old your sister is.
- 3 Say what there is to do at the party.
- 4 Say what present you have bought.
- 5 Name **one** thing your friend can bring to the party.

Myself

Instructions to the candidate:

You are telling your German exchange partner about yourself.

Your teacher will play the part of your German exchange partner.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Say how old you are.
- 2 Say when your birthday is.
- 3 Give **two** details about your family.
- 4 Say what pets you have.
- 5 Say what you are going to do next weekend.

SITUATION H

Cinema

Instructions to the candidate:

You are talking to your German friend about going to the cinema.

Your teacher will play the part of your German friend.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Say how often you go to the cinema.
- 2 Say what type of films you like.
- 3 Say why.
- 4 Suggest a day and time.
- 5 Suggest a place to meet.

SITUATION I

At the market

Instructions to the candidate:

You are at a market in Austria.

Your teacher will play the part of the stallholder.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Ask for a vegetable of your choice.
- 2 Ask for 2 kilos.
- 3 Ask for some fruit of your choice.
- 4 Ask how much they cost.
- 5 Say no, thank you. That is too expensive.

Friends

Instructions to the candidate:

You are talking to your German exchange partner about your friend.

Your teacher will play the part of your German exchange partner.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Say what your friend is called.
- 2 Say when his/her birthday is.

- 5 Say what he/she did last weekend.

Your teacher will play the part of your Swiss friend.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Say at what time you get up.
- 2 Say what you have for breakfast.
- 3 Say where you eat breakfast.
- 4 Say what you do after breakfast.
- 5 Say how you help at home.

SITUATION L

Mobile phones

Instructions to the candidate:

You are talking to your German exchange partner about mobile phones.

Your teacher will play the part of your German exchange partner.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Say how long you have had your mobile phone.
- 2 Name **one** thing you do with your mobile phone.
- 3 Say how much your mobile costs a month.
- 4 Name **one** advantage of having a mobile phone.
- 5 Name **one** disadvantage of having a mobile phone.

SITUATION M

Local area

Instructions to the candidate:

On an exchange visit to Germany your host mother/father asks you about your local area.

Your teacher will play the part of the host mother/father.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Say where you live.
- 2 Say what there is to do in your local area.
- 3 Say how you get to the town centre.
- 4 Say what the weather is like.
- 5 Say what you like best in your area.

SITUATION N

Health and lifestyle

Instructions to the candidate:

You are discussing your health and lifestyle with your exchange partner.

Your teacher will play the part of the exchange student.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Name **two** sports you do.
- 2 Say what you eat to be healthy.
- 3 Say what you think of fast food.
- 4 Say how long you sleep usually.
- 5 Say what you will do in the future to stay healthy (e.g. drink more water, eat more fruit, do more sport).

SITUATION O

Town or country

Instructions to the candidate:

You are discussing the advantages and disadvantages of country living with a visiting geography teacher.

Your teacher will play the part of the geography teacher.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Say you like living in the country.
- 2 Give a reason.
- 3 Give a disadvantage.
- 4 Say what you do for the environment.
- 5 Say where you would like to live in the future.

SITUATION P

At the doctor's

Instructions to the candidate:

You are ill and at the doctor's.

Your teacher will play the part of the doctor.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Say what is wrong with you (e.g. sore head, fever ...).
- 2 Say how long you have been ill.
- 3 Name another symptom.
- 4 Ask how often.
- 5 Ask if you can go to school.

SITUATION Q

Summer holidays

Instructions to the candidate:

You are discussing summer holidays with your friend.

Your teacher will play the part of your friend.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Say where you went on holiday.
- 2 Say how you travelled.
- 3 Say what you did on holiday.
- 4 Say what you are doing next summer.
- 5 Say what you think of holidays with your family.

SITUATION R

At the train station

Instructions to the candidate:

You are at a train station in Germany.

Your teacher will play the part of the ticket salesperson.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Say where you want to travel to.
- 2 Say what kind of ticket you would like (e.g. single, return, day ticket).
- 3 Ask how much it is.
- 4 Ask if there is a restaurant nearby.
- 5 Ask when the next train goes.



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SESSION D

SITUATION S

In town

Instructions to the candidate:

You are asking for directions in a German town.

Your teacher will play the part of a local resident.

You will speak first.

- 1 Say you are from Northern Ireland.
- 2 Ask where the train station is.
- 3 Ask if there is a cinema in town.
- 4 Ask if it is far away.
- 5 Give your opinion of the town.

SITUATION T

Lifestyle

Instructions to the candidate:

You are talking to your German friend about your lifestyle.

Your teacher will play the part of your German friend.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Say which sports you do (**two** details).
- 2 Say what you eat that is healthy.
- 3 Say what you drink.
- 4 Give your opinion on smoking.
- 5 Say what time you normally go to bed.

Voluntary work

Instructions to the candidate:

You are talking to your German exchange partner about some voluntary work you do.

Your teacher will play the part of your German exchange partner.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Say what type of work you do (e.g. help in a school, hospital, church group).
- 2 Say when you work.
- 3 Give your opinion of the work.
- 4 Say **one** thing you don't like about the work.
- 5 Say you worked yesterday.

SITUATION V

Holidays

Instructions to the candidate:

You are talking to your German exchange partner about your holidays.

Your teacher will play the part of your exchange partner.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Say where you normally go on holiday.
- 2 Say who you go with.
- 3 Say how you travel.
- 4 Say how long you are there for.
- 5 Name **two** things you do on holiday.

Lifestyle

Instructions to the candidate:

You are talking to your German exchange partner about your lifestyle.

Your teacher will play the part of your German exchange partner.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Say what you like to eat.
- 2 Say what you do not like to eat.
- 3 Say what type of sport you do (**two** details).
- 4 Give a reason why sport is important.
- 5 Say what you will do in the future for your health (e.g. drink more water, eat more fruit, do more sport).

Where you live

Instructions to the candidate:

You are talking to your German exchange partner about where you live.

Your teacher will play the part of your German exchange partner.

Your teacher will speak first.

- 1 Name **one** thing you do in your local area.
- 2 Say what there is for tourists.
- 3 Say whether you live in the town or the country.
- 4 Give an advantage of where you live.
- 5 Say you would like to live in Germany.
