

UNIT 2 Task 1 Radio Script Evaluation Guidance

- Think back to the initial process of selecting stories and what you ended up with in your final piece. What decisions did you make which altered your final outcome?

WHY did you make these changes – what was the intended impact on your listeners?

- Consider the research process – did you uncover any information that changed:
 - (a) your decision to include a story;
 - (b) your story prioritisation/order;
 - (c) the angle of your story?

EXPLAIN the intended impact on your listeners.

- When you were in the controlled assessment did you read over and make specific changes to your story e.g. did you notice the sentence length was too long?

WHY were the changes important to make?

- Explain the importance of sticking to the 3 minute timing – how did this impact on your final piece?
- Did you have to change, edit or move the position of your clips, or identify and resolve any issues e.g. not effectively introducing the speaker when you were editing your script during the controlled assessment?

EXPLAIN your decision-making.

- Refer to specific language choices:

Did you edit down your writing - e.g. KISS (Keep It Short and Simple)? How did this impact on your vocabulary choices? (Give specific examples.)

Did you use simple/suitable vocabulary that was accessible to your audience?
