Candidates must complete parts **B, C and E**.

<p>Part B Justification of Choice Choose two dishes (starter and main OR main and dessert and accompaniments) that will reflect nutritional and dietary advice for older adults (65+ years) and justify the choice using the listed criteria. Include research (inc. referencing at least 2 types of source in the text) and provide a general discussion of the nutritional content of the dishes.</p>	<p>1200 words</p>
<p>Part C Planning (no costing requirement; and time plan to be reduced to two hours due to two dishes only); planning should include ingredient list (per dish), equipment list (per dish) and a combined shopping list.</p>	
<p>Part E Evaluate all aspects of the task</p>	<p>400 words</p>
<p>Total marks available: 40</p>	

Please note the above adaptations were approved by the Minister, Mr Peter Weir, on **6 November 2020** (ref: SUB 1902–2020 – Letter to Principals):

In GCSE Food and Nutrition, there will be a reduction in the content and word limit for the Controlled Assessment Task which will continue to be worth 50% of the qualification. There will not be the option for candidates to be assessed on all elements of the original controlled assessment task.

The proposal that has been accepted is that ALL candidates will **complete the adapted Parts B, C and E only** of the Controlled Assessment Task. **There will be no assessment of the practical activity (Part D).**

On 17 May 2021 the Education Minister, Peter Weir MLA, announced a return to public examinations during the next academic year, along with significant reductions in the assessment requirements across a range of CCEA qualifications and **confirmed that internally assessed tasks issued in the academic year 2019/20, and carried across into 2020/21, will be carried over for a further academic year for submission in Summer 2022.**
