This component will still be available for any candidates wishing to be assessed in all components.

For those students who started their GCSE course in September 2020 and are due to enter the GCSE in Summer 2022, should they choose to sit all components of the GCSE, they will receive the higher of either:

- the grade awarded on the basis of the outcome of the required components specified by CCEA; or
- the grade awarded on the basis of the outcome of the full set of components for that qualification.

In both cases the full specification content should still be delivered.

For candidates commencing their GCSE course in September 2021 and due to enter in Summer 2023, it is recommended that, as far as possible, the content areas are delivered in the order that they are listed in the specification in case of any further disruption to the academic year
