

Preparation for Adult Life Level 1 Specification Addendum

Exceptional Assessment Adaptations (for 2021–2022)

This addendum should be used in conjunction with the current specification.

Please note: This applies only to candidates cashing-in at qualification level in November 2021 or Summer 2022.

1. No temporary adaptations have been made to this specification due to public health restrictions for November 2021 or Summer 2022.
2. For candidates who hope to achieve a **Level 1 Award** in *Preparation for Adult Life* qualification in November 2021 or Summer 2022, centres can choose to **omit up to three units** of their choice:
 - Centre enters candidates and delivers the specification for six units, as detailed in the specification.
 - Centres may choose to omit one, two or three units of their choice from assessment and assess candidates on the remaining units.
 - Units that have been previously awarded at unit level will count towards the number of units required for cash-in at qualification level in November 2021 or Summer 2022.

Unit level awards will still be available and moderated in the normal way.

3. For candidates who hope to achieve a **Level 1 Certificate** in *Preparation for Adult Life* qualification in November 2021 or Summer 2022, centres can choose to **omit up to six units** of their choice:
 - Centre enters candidates and delivers the specification for 13 units, as detailed in the specification.
 - Centres may choose to omit up to six units of their choice from assessment and assess candidates on the remaining units.
 - Units that have been previously awarded at unit level will count towards the number of units required for cash-in at qualification level in November 2021 or Summer 2022.

Unit level awards will still be available and moderated in the normal way.

4. For candidates who have already achieved a Level 1 Award (based on 6 units) and are hoping to achieve a Level 1 Certificate in November 2021 or Summer 2022, centres can choose to **omit up to three units** of their choice:
 - Centre enters and delivers the specification for the 7 remaining units as detailed in the specification.
 - Centres may choose to omit one, two or three units of their choice from assessment and assess candidates on the remaining units.
