MAKING ORAL PRESENTATIONS USING ARTEFACTS

Introduction

The AS1 Speaking Exam requires you to give a presentation based on an AS level theme related to an aspect of a German speaking country/community where German is spoken. You may use an artefact or realia to support your presentation, but no marks are awarded for the artefact or realia.

Assessment

The presentation is assessed according to the A04 criterion.

Assessment Objective/s

A04: knowledge and understanding of and respond critically and analytically to different aspects of the culture and society of countries/communities where the language is spoken and demonstrate critical analysis and evaluation of works created in the language studied.





Skills

Here are some suggestions to help you prepare for this skills area.

[ii] Artefacts:

- Remember that the presentation assess your knowledge of the topic selected and your linguistic competence. There are no marks available for the quality of your artefacts or realia.
- Your presentation must relate to an aspect of a German speaking country/ community.
- You could, for example, bring along a piece of the Berlin wall, if you choose to talk about youth culture in East Berlin in the 1980s.
- Similarly, for example, you could bring along some German bread, if you choose to talk about food in Germany.
