

Regulatory Document List



Introduction

This document is the official 'Regulatory Document List' referred to in Condition J1.8 of the CCEA General Conditions of Recognition. It replaces all previous versions of this list.

The documents listed within this Regulatory Document List are the Regulatory Documents (as defined in Condition J1.8) that are currently in force for those awarding organisations recognised by CCEA Regulation to operate in Northern Ireland.

About Regulatory Documents

Regulatory Documents contain qualification-specific rules and guidance.

Our General Conditions of Recognition require an awarding organisation to ensure that:

- it complies with any requirement to take or to refrain from taking any action specified in a Regulatory Document
- it has regard to any guidelines or principles of good practice in relation to any behaviour on the part of an awarding organisation set out in a Regulatory Document
- any qualification it makes available, or proposes to make available, complies with any requirement relating to that qualification which is set out in a Regulatory Document
- in the development, delivery and award of any qualification which it makes available, or proposes to make available, it has regard to any guidelines and principles of good practice relating to that qualification which are set out in a Regulatory Document
- it only makes available a qualification which uses a unit or Rule of Combination developed by another person where it reasonably believes that:
 - the unit or Rule of Combination complies with the requirements relating to it that are set out in any Regulatory Document
 - in the development of the unit or Rule of Combination, due regard has been had to the guidelines and principles of good practice set out in any Regulatory Document.

In any case of difference or contradiction, the CCEA General Conditions of Recognition (and where relevant, the Qualification Level Conditions for GCE and GCSE) will take precedence over any requirements or guidance set out in a Regulatory Document.
